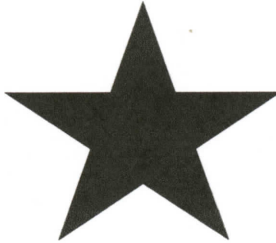


Serena's Star

If the pet is not your own, please include contact information for the pet owner, so that the SPCA may obtain permission to honor the pet through social and traditional media outlets.
