Southern Illinois University Programs at Risk of Elimination Without FY17 State Budget

SIUC

- **\$3,050,000 – Eliminate all state support to the School of Law**
 - State appropriated funding represents one-third of the Law School's total annual operating budget.
 - Tuition revenue will become the primary source of operating funds.
 - Lack of funding may impact reaccreditation by the American Bar Association that is underway this spring.

- **\$2,666,315 – Eliminate all state support to the Vice Chancellor for Development and Alumni Relations**
 - All state budget for the SIU Foundation and the SIUC Alumni Association will be eliminated.
 - Gift fees and unrestricted gifts currently used for the advancement of the university may be spent for Foundation and Alumni staff salaries.
 - Private support for SIUC may diminish.
 - 50 individuals removed from SIU payroll.

SIU School of Medicine

- **\$1,155,600 – MEDPREP (Medical/Dental Education Preparatory Program)**
 - Award-winning program to prepare underrepresented groups for medical/dental careers.

- **\$752,200 – Center for Rural Health and Social Service Development**
 - Provides health care and social services in rural communities.

- **\$1,183,400 – Basic Science Research**
 - Supporting all clinical areas represented by the School of Medicine.



Southern Illinois University System

SIUE

- **\$1,000,000 – Close the East St. Louis Campus, administer the grant programs from the Edwardsville campus and eliminate the remainder**
 - Close charter high school, dental clinic, nursing clinic, and the STEM Center.
 - Eliminate state funding support for Head Start and Upward Bound programs.
 - Eliminate SIUE support for community college programs in East St. Louis and the Department of Human Services.

- **\$2,030,800 – Eliminate all state support for the following research and service centers**
 - National Corn to Ethanol Research Center, the only center of its kind in the world
 - Small Business Development Center/International Trade Center
 - Institute for Urban Research
 - Early Childhood Center
 - The STEM Center
 - WSIE Radio Station
 - Career Development Center
 - Illinois Education Research Council
 - Kimmel Leadership Center
 - Office of Sustainability

- **\$2,200,000 – Review cost-shift options for SIU School of Dental Medicine**
 - Increase tuition by 30%, denying accessibility to Illinois students and increasing debt burden.
 - Possibly move organizational responsibility to SIU School of Medicine and expand practice plan opportunities.
